## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF WHITCHURCH-STOUFFVILLE BY-LAW NUMBER 2024-077-RE

BEING A BY-LAW to amend By-law 2019-092-RE, being a By-law to prohibit or regulate unusual noises or noises likely to disturb the inhabitants of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville.

**WHEREAS** section 129 of the *Municipal Act, 2001*, S.O. 2001, c. 25 (the "*Act*") provides that, without limiting sections 9, 10 and 11 of the *Act*, a municipality may: (a) prohibit and regulate with respect to noise, vibration, odour, dust and outdoor illumination, including indoor lighting that can be seen outdoors; and (b) prohibit the matters described in clause (a) unless a permit is obtained from the municipality for those matters and may impose conditions for obtaining, continuing to hold and renewing the permit, including requiring the submission of plans; and

**WHEREAS** Council passed By-law 2019-092-RE to prohibit and/or regulate unusual noises or noises likely to disturb the inhabitants of the Town of Whitchurch-Stouffville.

## NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF WHITCHURCH-STOUFFVILLE ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. By-law 2019-092-RE is hereby amended by adding a new section labelling it 7. Rebuttal Presumption and that the existing section 7. be numbered 8. and all section numbering thereafter be updated accordingly.
- 2. By-law 2019-092-RE is hereby further amended by adding the following to the new section 7:
  - 7.1 An Owner, whether present or absent from the property, where the Noise is being emitted from shall be presumed to have permitted, or caused to be permitted, the Noise under this Bylaw, as the case may be, which presumption may be rebutted by evidence to the contrary on a balance of probabilities.
